Ndeke Musee is a researcher at the Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) in the Pollution and Waste Division. He earned a PhD in Chemical Engineering Science from the University of Stellenbosch in 2004. He has authored several peer reviewed journal articles in the fields of risk assessment of environmental pollutants including nanomaterials. He is a registered professional scientist with the South African Council for Natural Scientific Professions, a member of two professional organizations, three national scientific steering committees, and a former holder of several highly competitive postgraduate and research fellowships. Since August 2007, as the leading scientist and project leader he has championed the development of South Africa National Risk Assessment Framework of nanomaterials for the Department of Science and Technology. He is the former chair and organizing convener of the *First South Africa National Workshop on Nanotechnology Risk Assessment* held in April 2009. Recently, he has presented papers, or invited presentations concerning the risk assessment of nanomaterials in biological and environmental systems in different forums in South Africa.
